

Call for applications for funding the visits of foreign guest lecturers and practitioners in 2025

Funded activities

The funding is allocated to Lithuanian higher education institutions (hereinafter referred to as higher education institutions), to which guest lecturers and practitioners from foreign states arrive (hereinafter referred to as foreign lecturers) under study programmes, subjects, or modules, which are an integral part of the implemented study programme.

Eligible participants of the activity

High qualification lecturers, foreign state higher education and research institution scientists and practitioners, except Russian and Belarusian citizens.

Eligible applicants

Higher education institutions.

Requirements and priorities

We would like to note that this invitation is for the calendar year of 2025, and there will be no other invitation for the year of 2025.

The following requirements and priorities are needed:

- The funding is allocated to higher education institutions that invite foreign lecturers **for academic activity**. The activity will be implemented **in the calendar year of 2025, i.e., from 1 January 2025 to 15 December 2025 inclusively**.
- **The duration** of the funded visit for lecturing **is from 10 to 15 days of work with students** (hereinafter referred to as a day of lecturing). In exceptional cases, when the higher education institution submits a reasoned application / verification, the duration of the visit may be shorter than 10 days, but not shorter than 5 days of lecturing (this information must be provided in the application). The days of the visit when no work with students is carried out shall not be funded.
- The workload of the foreign lecturer per one day of lecturing must not be less than 2 hours of contact work with students. The working hours comprise formally scheduled direct communication of the lecturer with the students, but do not encompass distant (online) training, with the exception approved by the Minister for Education, Science and Sport (Order of the Minister of 17 January 2017, No. V-18 "On the approval of the Description of the Procedure for Allocating State Budget Funds for Higher Education Institutions, which invite foreign guest lecturers and practitioners", <https://www.e-tar.lt/portal/lt/legalAct/cf302340dc7d11e69ae9f38427b46dd7/asr>, (hereinafter referred to as the Order of the Minister), which allows distant (online) training due to the military actions of the Russian Federation in Ukraine, if the foreign lecturer is a citizen of Ukraine and is unable to come to Lithuania due to the martial law in Ukraine. In this case, the work of the foreign lecturer at a distance shall be counted as part of the period of the foreign lecturer's visit, for which full funding shall be provided.

- Additional activities of the lecturer, such as public lectures, research work, training of academic and administrative personnel as well as other activities that are beneficial for the higher education institution and (or) wider society, creates added value for the visit (such information must be indicated in the application and the preliminary programme of the visit).
- Funding may be allocated for the visit of a foreign lecturer in case the funds allocated for the visit of the foreign lecturer by the higher education institution comprise not less than 30 percent of all the means necessary for the whole visit.

Selection criteria

The selection criteria for funding a visit of a particular foreign lecturer are as follows:

- Validity of the need and expediency of the visit of foreign lecturer;
- The benefit of the visit for the students;
- The benefit of the visit for higher education institution;
- The validity of the lectured subject (module) as an integral part of the implemented study programme;
- Additional activities undertaken by the foreign lecturer during the visit;
- Pedagogical, scientific (artistic) work or practical experience of the foreign lecturer;
- The motivation of the higher education institution to admit a foreign lecturer of Lithuanian origin or an emigrant;
- The share of the funds allocated by the higher education institution for funding the visit of the foreign lecturer.

When ranking the competing applications, the applications assessed by the experts are listed in decreasing order in accordance with the received qualitative assessment score and the list of financed visits of the foreign lecturers and a reserve list is made. Reserve list can be financed in case there are unused funds. The application will be assessed as not funded if the criteria for the purpose and justification of the foreign lecturer's visit and the benefit of the visit to the students are less than half of the possible points in the evaluation.

Funding for the activity

The size of the support allocated under the competition:

- in case the foreign lecturer meets the requirements established for scientists or acknowledged artists aspiring to work in a position of a professor at the higher education institution – **440,00 Eur** for one day of lecturing;
- in case the foreign lecturer meets the requirements established for scientists or acknowledged artists aspiring to work in a position of a senior lecturer (associate professor) at the higher education institution – **330,00 Eur** for one day of lecturing;
- in case the foreign lecturer meets the requirements established for the position of an assistant, junior assistant, lecturer, senior lecturer at the higher education institution – **165,00 Eur** for one day of lecturing.

IMPORTANT: due to the amendment of paragraph 1 of Article 68 of the Law on Higher Education and Research (<https://www.e-tar.lt/portal/lt/legalAct/TAR.C595FF45F869/asr>) guest lecturers can only be lecturers from other higher education and research institutions who meet the requirements of the leading researcher or recognized researcher career stage. Lecturers who meet only the requirements for assistant, junior assistant, senior lecturer and lecturer positions and who do not meet the requirements for the career stage of leading researcher or recognized researcher shall not be eligible to be guest lecturers. Also, due to the amendment of paragraph 8 of Article 65 of the Law on Higher Education and Research, higher education institutions can establish various positions of practitioners and invite practitioners who do practical work in organisations other than higher education and research institutions, have at least 3 years of experience in such practical work related to the field of teaching, professional achievements and meet the teaching competencies provided by the higher education institution.

The support allocated under the competition is indexed applying a rate of 1.5 for a foreign lecturer arriving from the country whose capital is more than 5,000 kilometres away from Vilnius*, irrespectively of the duration of the visit for giving lectures.

The funding allocated for the foreign lecturer can be used for reimbursing:

- travel expenses;
- accommodation expenses;
- wages.

Applications are submitted by the higher education institutions. Application deadline: 29 November 2024, 12 pm.

All the submitters of the applications will be notified about the results of the competition by the end of January 2025.
